



DISCRIMINATION IN PUBLIC ACCOMMODATIONS



WELCOME! KENTUCKY LAW REQUIRES

THAT EVERY PERSON SHALL RECEIVE FULL AND EQUAL SERVICE IN A BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENT

THIS KENTUCKY CIVIL RIGHTS ACT PROHIBITS DISCRIMINATION IN PUBLIC ACCOMMODATIONS BASED ON RACE, COLOR, DISABILITY, RELIGION, OR NATIONAL ORIGIN. SEX IS A PROTECTED CLASS IF THE PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION IS A RESTAURANT, HOTEL, MOTEL, OR IS SUPPORTED DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY BY GOVERNMENT FUNDS. A PLACE OF PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION, RESORT OR AMUSEMENT INCLUDES ANY PLACE, STORE OR OTHER ESTABLISHMENT EITHER LICENSED OR UNLICENSED, WHICH SUPPLIES GOODS OR SERVICES TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC OR WHICH SOLICITS OR ACCEPTS THE PATRONAGE OR TRADE OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC OR WHICH IS SUPPORTED DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY BY GOVERNMENT FUNDS.

IT IS OUR POLICY TO FULLY COMPLY WITH THE KENTUCKY CIVIL RIGHTS ACT
